

## **WORKING TIME REGULATIONS**

I agree to the working week limit not applying whilst on assignments with Aligra, as per the Working Time Regulations 1998 – Opt Out Agreement

### **Restriction**

The Working Time Regulations 1998 (as amended) provide that the Employee shall not work on an Assignment with the Client in excess of the Working Week unless s/he agrees in writing that this limit should not apply.

### **Consent**

The Employee hereby agrees that the Working Week limit shall not apply to the Assignment.

### **Withdrawal of Consent**

- The Employee may end this Agreement by giving the Company 3 weeks' notice in writing.
- For the avoidance of doubt, any notice bringing this Agreement to an end shall not be construed as termination by the Employee of an Assignment with a Client.
- Upon the expiry of the notice period set out in clause 4.1 the Working Week limit shall apply with immediate effect.

### **The Law**

This Agreement is governed by the law of England & Wales and is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England & Wales
